**SILVERADO RESORT ANNOUNCES THE “SUITE SEASON” BEGINNING NOV. 18;

NAPA, Calif., Nov. 8, 2007 – The Silverado Resort in Napa Valley will drop the price of its junior, one- and two-bedroom suites beginning Nov. 18, 2007. Called the “Suite Season,” the reduced off-season rates will be in effect through Feb. 29, 2008. The rates are as much as 38 percent lower than summer-season rates.

Rates per night are \$190 all week for a junior suite and \$205 for a one-bedroom suite and \$265 for a two-bedroom suite Sunday through Thursday. On Friday and Saturday nights, the rates are \$260 for a one-bedroom suite and \$310 for a two-bedroom suite. Summer rates range from \$265 to \$475. Rates do not include taxes and surcharges.

The 280 condominium units and private cottage suites surround the fairways of the resort’s two championship golf courses. Each of the suites includes a kitchen, dining area and balcony or patio as well as many other amenities.

Encompassing 1,200 acres in Napa Valley, Silverado Resort has been providing an upscale experience for more than 40 years. Guests of Silverado Resort have access to all of the resort’s facilities, including its 16,000-square-foot spa with 16 treatment rooms, an exercise facility and full-service salon; 17 tennis courts; swimming pools; volleyball courts; basketball courts; jogging trails; and 10-speed mountain bikes for rent.
