**NAPA VALLEY'S SILVERADO RESORT TO DROP RATES
ON POPULAR GOLFER'S DREAM AND SPA GIRL PACKAGES**

NAPA VALLEY, October 30, 2007 – Silverado Resort in Napa Valley will drop the price of two of its popular packages for golfers and spa aficionados beginning Nov. 18.

The Golfer's Dream Package includes accommodations in a one bedroom suite and golf for two, including cart, for 18 holes per night's stay. From Nov. 18, 2007 through Feb. 29, 2008, the Golfer's Dream Package is priced at \$199 per room on Sunday through Thursday nights and \$289 per room on Friday and Saturday. The package represents a savings of more than 50 percent off regular prices of the package components.

From November 18, 2007 through March 31, 2008, the resort is offering the Spa Girl Package at a special price of \$230 per person per night Sunday through Thursday based on double occupancy in a one-bedroom suite or triple occupancy in a two-bedroom suite. The cost is \$250 per person per night on Friday and Saturday. All taxes and gratuities are included. Guests receive accommodations in luxurious suites at the Silverado Resort, a 50-minute spa treatment at the Spa at Silverado, breakfast at the grill at Silverado or the Spa café and use of spa facilities and tennis courts. Guests also receive a wine-tasting at the William Hill Estate and a Silverado canvas tote.
